

# Craft Beers from South of the Mason Dixon Line (39° N)

## *And some imported crafts from outside The South*

- La Tropical Pilsener** (Coral Gables, FL - 5.02%) 4  
The original 1888 formula of the Award winning Cuban beer in exile since 1960. Medium bodied with a smooth, clean taste
- Ybor Gold Amber Lager** (Melbourne, FL – 4.6%) 4  
A medium bodied, amber color Vienna style lager with distinctive citrus hops and toasty malt on the nose and on the palate. Drinks balanced and smooth with a lingering hop finish
- Key West Southernmost Wheat** (Key West, FL – 5.1%) 4  
A pale colored Belgian style wit bier. Coriander and orange peel, aromas. Medium-bodied and slightly hoppy with subtle orange, lime and wheat flavors. A refreshing beer for a warm Florida day.
- Lazy Magnolia “Southern Pecan” Nut Brown Ale** (Kiln, MS – 4.25%) 5  
The world's only beer brewed with whole roasted pecans. Nutty aroma, easy drinking with malt, caramel, and pecan flavors
- Stoudt's Brewery Scarlet Lady Ale ESB** (Adamstown, PA – 5%) 5  
English-style Extra Special Bitter ale with a medium body, copper color, a smooth malty palate and a hoppy finish
- Dunedin Brewery “Red Head” Red Ale** (Dunedin, FL – 5.2%) 5  
A handcrafted Celtic Red Ale that pours deep amber in color with caramel, malt and floral hops aromas. Roasted malt and fruit hop flavors are well rounded and leaves a nice slightly dry finish
- Abita Turbodog** (Abita Springs, LA – 6.13%) 5  
An English Brown Ale that pours dark with chocolate, caramel & nut aromas. Drinks a bit lighter than it looks. Very smooth, crisp and refreshing with a great balanced hop and malt finish
- Dixie Blackened Voodoo Lager** (New Orleans, LA – 5%) 5  
A well done Munich Dunkel Lager that pours dark brown, is rich and complex, but not heavy or aggressive. Rich toasted malt and a bit of hops and caramel flavor round out this tasty brew
- Flying Dog “Road Dog” Porter** (Frederick, MD – 6%) 5  
A dark, rich and malty Scottish style porter with hints of chocolate, coffee, fresh bread and licorice. The label says it all...
- Clipper City Heavy Seas “Small Craft Warning”** (Baltimore, MD – 7%) 5  
A very smooth golden Munich Pilsner. A noble spicy-herbal hoppy nose. Crisp, medium in body, and refreshing with nice malt and hop balance and a smooth finish.
- Lazy Magnolia “Reb Ale” Deep South Pale Ale** (Kiln, MS – 5.4%) 5  
Crisp and clean with the perfect balance of medium hoppiness and crisp malt that has a subtle Confederate Jasmine aroma

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**Dogfish Head 60 Minute IPA** (Lewes, Delaware – 6%) 6

An easy to drink India Pale Ale with a good citrusy hop character, a little wood on the nose without being your typical “hop head” IPA. It is well balanced with some malt and has a nice, dry finish

**Orange Blossom Pilsner Squared** (Greenville, SC – 11%) 6

Brewed with all natural ingredients including Florida orange blossom honey. A full bodied pilsner with a bang. Aromas of orange zest & honey. Silky smooth mouth feel with orange, honey & floral flavors.

**Left Hand Milk Stout** (Longmont, CO – 5.2%) 6

Pours black with hints of smoke and chocolate aromas. Smooth mouth feel with creamy notes of milk chocolate and smoke flavors that finish smooth and dry

**Stone Brewery Oaked Arrogant Bastard Ale** (San Diego, CA – 7.2%) 7

An American strong ale with attitude. Sweet oak, toffee, and chocolate aromas with flavors of oak and hops. You're not worthy.

**Dogfish Head Midas Touch Ancient Ale** (Lewes, DE – 9%) 8

From the tomb of King Midas, this 2,700 year old recipe is the oldest known for any fermented beverage! Smooth, with honey, saffron, Muscat, papaya, melon. Unlike anything you've ever experienced before!

**Mississippi Mud Black & Tan** (Utica, NY – 5%) (32oz) 9

Pours out a nice deep brown color with a rich tan head. Notes of cocoa and malt on the nose. Nice rounded mouth full of malt & hops that finishes dry and smooth.

**Abita “Andygator”** (Abita Springs, LA – 8%) (22oz) 10

A German Style Doppelbock with bready malt on the nose, stone fruit and light honey flavors balanced with subtle earthy hops

**Abita Abbey Ale** (Abita Springs, LA – 8%) (22oz) 10

A well done, medium bodied tribute to the Belgian Monks' Abbey Dubbel Ale. Nice malt, fruit and spice on the nose. Creamy mouth feel. Layered and complex flavors of fruit, caramel, malt and clove.

**Rogue Chipotle Ale** (Newport, OR – 5.5%) (22oz) 13

An unusual amber ale with a malty and slightly smokey nose. Delicately spiced with smoked chipotle peppers leaving a pleasant warm feeling as it goes down. A must have with the ribs or jerk chicken.
